## Kitzsteinhorn

*Guaranteed snow at the glacier*

The Kitzsteinhorn in Kaprun, open 365 days a year, is Salzburg's only glacier ski resort and offers 100% guaranteed snow conditions from October to early summer. With its wide glacier slopes, freeride and ski touring routes and world-class snow parks, there is truly something for everyone here. From winter 2019/20, the new 3K K-connection, Salzburg's first tricable gondola lift, will directly connect the town centre with the glacier via the Maiskogel family ski resort. In addition, Kaprun continues to set new standards with the 12-km cable car axis extending from the centre of Kaprun to an altitude of 3,029 metres above sea level. The astounding 2,261 m in altitude difference are the biggest in the Eastern Alps! But wait there's more: The "Top of Salzburg" panorama platform is undoubtedly one of the country's true Alpine highlights, offering fascinating views of Austria's highest peaks and the adjacent Hohe Tauern National Park.
